











476. KATE'S GOLD LOCKET NECKLACE. Kate's gold locket from the episode, "I Do." In the flashback sequence, Kate, going by the alias "Monica," receives a golden locket from her future mother-in-law. The locket embodies Kate's effort to lead a normal life and stop running from the law. \$200 - \$300





477. KATE AND KEVIN'S WEDDING RINGS. While still a fugitive, Kate falls in love with a police officer named Kevin and tries to assume a new life. They get married but it is short lived as Kate soon realizes that she can't continue hiding her true identity and goes on the run again. Seen in the flashback sequence in the episode, "I Do." \$200 – \$300



478. KATE'S HANDCUFFS. Pair of metal handcuffs worn by Kate in the episodes, "A Tale of Two Cities" and, "Left Behind." **\$300 - \$500**





479. HURLEY'S CANTEEN BOTTLE WITH KNIFE PUNCTURE. After Hurley is released by the Others, he runs back to tell the other survivors what happened. Locke accidentally throws a knife at Hurley as he emerges from the jungle thinking Hurley was a polar bear. The knife hits the canteen that Hurley was holding in front of him. Seen in the episode, "Further Instructions." \$200 - \$300







481. SAWYER'S IMPROVISED READING GLASSES FROM SEASON THREE. After crashing onto the Island, Sawyer shows an odd passion for reading literature, but soon begins experiencing headaches. Coming to his aid, Jack realizes he is farsighted, and gives him a pair of glasses welded together to match his prescription. This improvised pair from Season Three is held together with electrical wire and black electrical tap. \$600 - \$800

MR. CLUCK'S CHICKEN SHACK PROP "MR. CLUCK" HEAD. Measuring approximately 34 in. x 40 in. and made of Styrofoam--with slight damage on top--the prop chicken head is the symbol of the Mr. Cluck's Chicken Shack fast food franchise. It is while employed there that Hurley wins the Mega Lotto Jackpot. However, before telling anyone about winning the lottery, Hurley is accused by his boss for eating an 8piece combo meal. Hurley quits and later returns to buy the franchise with some of his lottery winnings. A local news reporter, Tricia Tanaka, is doing a story on Hurley and the re-launching of Mr. Cluck's when a meteorite hits the restaurant and further extends Hurley's belief that his life is cursed. \$300 - \$500

483. Two **(2) DHARMA-**BRANDED BEER CANS BELONGING TO SAWYER. Two DHARMA-branded beer cans belonging to Sawyer. Both are opened/empty and distressed. As seen in the episode, "Tricia Tanaka is Dead." **\$200** – **\$300**





485. Hurley and Sawyer's makeshift ping pong paddles and balls. The Survivors build a ping pong table from materials found at the Swan station remains. Sawyer offers a whiffle golf ball to the group and challenges Hurley to a game to win back his stash in the episode, "Enter 77." \$200 - \$300




486. Sawyer's two (2) rubber stunt knives with sheaths. Two stunt knives, with sheathes, belonging to Sawyer. \$200 - \$300





487. SAWYER'S ARREST REPORT AS "JAMES FORD." Sawyer's Knoxville, TN state police arrest report as "James Ford." Includes police folder with associated papers. \$200 - \$300







488. Locke's CA driver's license and registration. Locke's CA driver's license and vehicle registration certificate, seen in the flashback sequence of the episode, "Further Instructions." While carrying guns in the bed of his truck, Locke picks up a drifter named Eddie. They are stopped by the local sheriff, who asks to see Locke's license and registration. When the sheriff threatens to cite Locke for picking up hitchhikers, Eddie mitigates the situation by claiming that Locke is his uncle. Includes Locke's mom, "Emily Annabeth Locke," CA driver's license. \$300 - \$500



490. Collection of Rubber Stunt Knives belonging to Locke. Five (5) varying stunt versions of Locke's hunting knife; one is a rigged special effects knife. Used from Season Three onward throughout the series. \$300 - \$500






491. Locke's Flash-forward coffin with rolling base as seen in the episode, "Through the Looking Glass," when a depressed and disheveled Jack is the only mourner at the funeral viewing. Made entirely of wood and measures 4 ft. x 8 ft. x 32 in. * Special shipping arrangements will apply. \$300 – \$500



492. SAYID'S PERSONAL BELONGINGS. Sayid's laminated Iraqi photo identification card was used in the flashback sequence while he was in Paris in the episode, "Enter 77." The French driver's license, not shown in the episode, shows Sayid's picture with the name, "Shakir Al-Sayyab Badr," a possible alias from the time Sayid worked for the CIA. Also includes wallet with various credits cards and currencies. \$200 – \$300





494. SAYID'S BACKPACK WITH PROP C-4 LOCKE REMOVED FROM THE FLAME STATION. Sayid uses this backpack in the episode, "Par Avion." In the same episode, Sayid discovers this prop C-4 block in Locke's backpack which he had taken from the Flame station with the intent of blowing up the submarine. \$200 - \$300

493. SAYID'S DHARMA CABLING MAP SHOWING THE BARRACKS. The DHARMA cabling map is the map that Sayid finds in the DHARMA Operations Manual after capturing Mikhail Bakunin at the Flame station. The map shows the Flame station as a central hub for the cables, one of which leads to an area called the Barracks, which Sayid believes is where the Others are staying. Cable relay/switching points are also shown, along with the station's satellite dish. \$200 - \$300








495. SUN'S BROKEN GLASS BAL-LERINA. Pieces of a broken glass ballerina, a Paik family home ornament that a young Sun accidentally drops. Seen in the opening scene of the episode, "The Glass Ballerina." When the young Sun is confronted by her domineering father, she steadfastly lies and blames the maid, despite her father's threat to fire the maid as a consequence. Includes a painted plaster maquette of the "glass ballerina." \$300 – \$500

497. AARON'S CRIB AFTER ATTACKED BY THE OTHERS. Aaron's wooden crib built by Locke for Claire and Aaron, with studio distress exhibiting damage after the camp was attacked by the Others in the episode, "Through the Looking Glass, Part 1." **\$200 - \$300**




498. CHARLIE'S "DS" RING. This ring, bearing the initials "DS," was worn by Charlie on his right hand middle finger and is a Pace family heirloom. It bears the initials of Dexter Stratton, Charlie's great-grandfather. The ring was passed down to Charlie's brother, Liam, and named their band, "Drive Shaft," after the initials on the ring. Liam later gives the ring to Charlie, deeming him more of a family man with a greater likelihood of passing the ring along to an heir. Charlie wore the ring for the 91 days he survived on the island. Before leaving for his fatal mission to the Looking Glass station, Charlie leaves this ring in Aaron's crib, symbolically passing the ring on to his adopted son. \$1,000 - \$1,500




